

ROBERT EARL MAXWELL, (D), of Elkins, was born on March 15, 1924, the son of Earl L. Maxwell and Nellie E. Maxwell; educated in Randolph County Schools and Davis and Elkins College; LL.B. College of Law, West Virginia University in 1949; married Ann Marie Grabowski in March, 1948; four children, Mary Ann, Carel Lynn, Ellen Lindany and Earl Wiscon; commenced private practice of law in Randolph County, June 1, 1949; member of Randolph County Bar Association, The West Virginia State Bar, the West Virginia Bar Association, American Bar Association and American Judicature Society; Catholic; elected Prosecuting Attorney of Randolph County in 1952, reelected 1956 and 1960; appointed United States Attorney for the Northern District of West Virginia by President Kennedy on March 15, 1961, resigned January 31, 1964 to return to private practice; elected Delegate to Democratic National Conventions in 1956 and 1964; appointed by President Johnson on July 19, 1965, as Judge of the United States District Conference of the United States, Member, Committee of the Federal Judicial Center supervising the preparation of Federal Judicial Bench Book; Faculty Member, Federal Judicial Center; President, District Judges' Association, Fourth Circuit; 1989 recipient Alumni Distinguished Service Award from Davis and Elkins Cellege.
