THE HONORABLE LARRIE BAILEY
 TREASURER OF THE STATE OF WEST VIRGINIA



The Honorable Larrie Bailey is only the 20th person to be Treasurer of West Virginia. He is a graduate of Weston High School, The University of South Carolina, and West Virginia University, from which he earned a Masters Degree in Political Science in 1966. In the 30 months he has served as Treasurer of the State of West Virginia, Larrie Bailey has been directly responsible for more significant changes in the management and operation of the Treasurer's Office than any of his 19 predecessors. During his first two years in office he earned more than \$230 million in interest on State Investments.

A U.S. Navy veteran, Lt. Commander Bailey served as National Vice President for Navy, Marine Corps and Coast Guard of the Reserve Officer's Association of the United States and also has been the Commanding Officer of the largest Naval Reserve Unit in West Virginia.

Since he became Treasurer, the cumbersome hand-tended system which distributed State funds for disbursement among 229 banks, has been reduced to five, all quickly managed by computer.

Computer control of State accounts and funds has allowed closer management of cash flow, with the result that the Treasurer is able to continually, and on a daily basis, invest over 100 percent of State monies in interest bearing instruments. Interest earnings on investments this year will top last year's record mark of \$112 million.

He is married to the former Joyce Kennedy of Fairmont, and they are the parents of three children.
