S. District Court for the Southern District of West Virginia (1958); Attorney in Charge, Legal Aid Society of Kanawha and Putnam Counties (1959-1960); private practice, Charleston (1958-1962); appointed State Commissioner of Public Institutions June 1, 1962; elected Attorney General in 1966; reelected, 1972 and 1976.
