PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION CHAIRMAN DAN MCDONALD ADDRESSES BOYS' STATE CITIZENS AT EVENING MEAL

The Chairman of the West Virginia Public Service Commission, E. Dandridge McDonald, addressed the Boys' State evening meal assembly on June 19. The Chairman congratulated the citizens on their

accomplishments that lead to their selection for Boys' State, and then explained to the citizens that the function of the PSC was to regulate the rates and practices of the various electric, gas, water, and telephone utilities that operate as natural monopolies in the State. "The PSC is charged with the responsibioity of seeing that these lawful monopolies do not extract excessive profits from their customers, but are still able to earn adequate returns for the owners and shareholders of the businesses," said McDonald. 
