
SPEAKERS OF THE DAY

KEN HECHLER (D) of Huntington, born September 20, 1914; single; AB Swarthmore College, 1935; MA Columbia University, 1940; Instructor in Government, Columbia and Barnard Colleges, 1937-41; Research Assistant, Judge Samuel I. Rosenman and President Franklin D. Roosevelt in editing and annotation of The Public Papers and Addresses of Franklin D. Roosevelt: Personnel Officer, Office for Emergency Management, Washington, D.C., 1941; Administrative Analyst, U.S. Bureau of Budget, 1942 and 1946; U.S. Army, 1942-46; Graduate, Armored Force Officer Candidate School; commissioned 2nd Lieutenant, 1943; European Theatre of Operations as Combat Historian and promoted to Major, 1944-45; Awarded Bronze Star and five battle stars, Normandy to the Elbe; military expert on 5-man War Department Mission to interrogate Hermann Goering, Joachim von Ribbentrop and other Nazi military leaders, 1945; Assistant Professor of Politics, Princeton University, 1947-49; Research Director and Special Assistant to President Harry S. Truman, 1949-53; Associate Director, The American Political Science Association, Washington, D.C., 1953-55; Research Director, presidential campaign Adlai Stevenson, 1956-57; Associate Professor, Political Science, Marshall University, 1957; Member, U.S. House of Representatives, 1959-77; Science Consultant, U.S. House of Representatives Committee on Science and Technology, 1978-80; Adjunct Professor, Political Science, Marshall University, 1982-84; Member, Board of Directors, West Virginia Humanities Foundation, 1981-84; Delegate to Democratic National Conventions 1964, 1968, 1972, 1980, 1984; Author of several books and papers, including The Bridge at Remagen; elected Secretary of State in 1984; reelected in 1988.


