

<u>PURPOSE</u>: The American Legion Mountaineer Boys State (ALMBS) has been a program of The American Legion, Department of West Virginia since 1936. ALMBS participants are exposed to the rights, privileges, duties, and responsibilities of a franchised citizen. The training is objective and practical with city, county, and state governments operated by the participants elected to the various offices. Activities include executive, legislative, and judicial sessions, law enforcement presentations, assemblies with a variety of guest speakers, and Americanism presentations. Band, chorus, and recreational activities are also parts of the program.

ALMBS was created to teach good government through participation. Participants receive instruction and hands on experience in the governmental, political, and legal processes and participate in a variety of "career paths" that include Political, Legal, Banking, Law Enforcement, Journalism (Broadcast & Print), Homeland Security (National Guard), Corrections, and Emergency Services.

BENEFITS: Attendees of ALMBS are eligible to apply for the Samsung Scholarship, if they are direct descendants of a US wartime veteran, worth up to \$10,000 towards any higher education institution, including but not limited to, state, private, and technical institutions. All graduates are also eligible for numerous leadership scholarships at private and public colleges and universities across the nation. ALMBS attendees also receive extra merit points toward admission to all US Military Service Academies. Most importantly, attendees also become a member of an elite group of individuals that have graduated from "A Week That Shapes A Lifetime!"

Note: All applicants of the Samsung Scholarship will submit an online application. During the application process, the applicant is required to provide their high school official contact information for confirmation of GPA, class ranking, etc. Please be prepared to respond to these requests so that your students can successfully be considered for potentially \$10,000 in scholarship funds.

As of the 2019 ALMBS, The American Legion Department of West Virginia provided <u>ALL</u> graduates a red, white, and blue graduation honor cord. Please remind and permit these ALMBS Graduates from your school to wear the honor cord during their high school commencement.

COST: The entire cost for one boy to attend ALMBS is \$250.00. A local American Legion post(s), or sponsor(s) they are able to obtain, usually pay this fee. ALMBS is always looking for sponsors and perhaps you may have some civic group(s), individual(s) or business(s) in your community that would be willing to underwrite the cost of sending a boy(s) to ALMBS. If so, please contact your local American Legion Post or The American Legion Department of West Virginia Headquarters at 1-888-534-4667. An interested applicant may also locate his own sponsor or he and/or his family may pay the \$250.00 fee, which covers lodging and meal expenses at the WVU Jackson's Mill facility. The American Legion Mountaineer Boys State, Inc. is a non-profit 501(C)(3) tax-exempt organization and any donation to ALMBS is tax deductible as allowed by applicable law.

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QUALIFICATIONS: All eligible candidates must:

- 1. Be a member of the male enrollment of the junior class;
- 2. Have a 2.75 grade point average or higher on a four-point scale or its equivalent (**Note:** schools should use the most current cumulative grade point average as of the time of their response);
- 3. Have demonstrated outstanding qualities in the areas of school activities, community activities, and character;
- 4. Have never attended a Boys State program previously and
- 5. Be a citizen of West Virginia OR attend a high school in West Virginia

ALMBS is open to those meeting the above requirements regardless of race, creed, or national origin.

<u>PROCEDURE</u>: It is requested that the high school principal/counselor(s) provide ALMBS with a list of <u>ALL</u> students who meet the qualifications by completing the attached form and return it to The American Legion Mountaineer Boys State, c/o Director Jim Davis, P.O. Box 3191, Charleston, West Virginia 25332, as soon as possible, <u>but no later than November 15, 2019</u>.

You may also provide the list of <u>ALL</u> students who meet the qualifications by exporting a report directly from WVEIS or other appropriate data management system. When preparing the report please ensure the students first name, last name, complete mailing address, and phone number are present.

Please make this once in a lifetime opportunity available to <u>ALL</u> of your students who meet the QUALIFICATIONS by listing their names and contact information on the enclosed form(s). *Please make a copy for your records and forward a copy to your local American Legion Post*.

Please remember that the enclosed "ELIGIBLE CANDIDATES FORM" is not an application. We will provide application information once the candidates have been identified from the enclosed form(s). The American Legion will screen the applicants and select those for admission. Unfortunately, because of the size of the facilities at WVU Jackson's Mill and the number of sponsors that the local American Legion Posts are able to obtain, we cannot guarantee that every boy that you list will be able to attend.



All eligible candidates, who apply for admission, must be able to commit to participate for the entire duration of the ALMBS.

Please check with your local American Legion Post or The American Legion Department of West Virginia before promising any student that they will be attending ALMBS.
